The non-refundable entry fee for this event will be as follows: - 50 EUR per gymnast; - 150 EUR per gymnasts, who have not booked their accommodation and meals through LOC.		
The accreditation procedure will take place at the competition hall.  Heads of delegation must keep the accreditation schedule, which will be distributed by LOC before the official date of arrival.  Heads of delegation have to bring to the accreditation office:  • passports of all participants  • passport copies of all participants — on paper  • Negative COVID-19 test or proof of all delegation members.  regardless of whether this is necessary for entering the country or not and regardless of whether the person has been vaccinated.  • national anthem  • national flag  • 1 CD per music  • Certification of insurance for all delegation members covering illness, accidents and repatriation — on paper  • Proof for full payment towards the LOC (copy of the SWIFT to be given to the LOC)  • Separate declarations for use of personal data — on paper and signed  In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.

COVID-19	Besides the medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions.	
	The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.	
	The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.	
	Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.	
	Due to the dynamic situation regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, we will keep you posted regarding all prevailing COVID-19 measures via email.	
VISA	Please, verify immediately with your travel agent or the Bulgarian Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Bulgaria. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made by <b>January 28<sup>th</sup> 2022</b> to the LOC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city of the Bulgarian Consular Department to which the official visa support letter must be sent.	
	Note: Bulgaria applies a visa-free system for holders of valid Schengen visas.	

## **INSURANCE** The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: 25 EUR per person/day. INTERNATIONAL The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. **TRANSPORTATION** The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 28th February 2022.
